- Identify and respond to the needs of multicultural clients who may be experiencing domestic and family violence
- Respond appropriately with immediate interventions and support needs of multicultural clients including safety planning
- Refer multicultural clients to appropriate services and support.

Nationally recognised training

Once each of the components of the DV-alert Assessment Pathway have been completed, you can enrol in the Assessment session. After successful completion of the assessments, you will achieve a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment for the unit of competency CHCDFV001 Recognise and respond appropriately to domestic and family violence.
